Along with his 7group partners and Bill Reed, he co-authored *The Integrative Design Guide to Green Building: Redefining the Practice of Sustainability*, the seminal text book for guiding integrative design and construction published by John Wiley & Sons in April 2009. As a highly sought keynote speaker and educator, John has facilitated hundreds of workshops on the benefits of integrative design and regenerative development in 36 states and 14 countries.
